Game Changer: Josh's Story

Josh entered our Reentry Program in the fall of 2021. Years of drug addiction and alcohol abuse, coupled with multiple jail sentences, resulted in losing his family, his jobs, and soon his housing. Josh landed on the streets, along with numerous others, his hopes for a positive future fading with each passing day. In August 2022, after a 3-month stint in CRASH (Community Resources and Self Help), Josh enrolled in Second Chance's Job Readiness Training (JRT) program.

That program became a game changer for him. After he completed the 4-week program, and learned job search skills and gained the confidence needed to find employment, Josh was successful in landing a job as a Building Technician at Citymark. Since last fall, he has already received two promotions - and is on his way toward achieving the stability and self-sufficiency he could only dream of years before. Josh also continues to develop his skills as a musician, sharing his gift with others, and hoping to inspire those still struggling to find what he had found: a second chance.
